Scope:

The Mid wife will support delivery of quality curative and preventive medical services to patients at the Medical Centre.

PRINCIPLE TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide quality curative and preventive medical services to our SOS families, staff and their immediate families; woks collaboratively with the visiting doctor and Medical Center Head.
- Carry out nursing activities as per standard operating procedures, ensuring that ethical requirements are considered
- Monitor the clinic and community based primary health care activities including immunization services, school health program, antenatal care and health education
- Conduct outreach mobile clinics / activities in the communities in and around our catchment areas
- Support implementation of family planning methods to women in the reproductive age group
- Plan activities as well as prepare periodic statistical reports and assist the SOS families to set up and maintain a balanced diet/menu.
- Support the implementation of the Uganda Voucher plus Project ensuring that quality maternal services are offered to the voucher mothers.
- Assist women in all stages of pregnancy, childbirth and post-delivery as per the standards of MOH guidelines.

Minimum Requirements:

- A mature woman / man aged between 25–30 years with a certificate in Enrolled midwifery from a recognized midwifery institution.
- Must be registered and lincensed with Nurses and Midwives Council
- At least 2 years' experience of active practice in a modern medical establishment / hospital. Knowledge and experience in basic nutritional practice shall be an added advantage.
- Must be Computer literate.
- Have interest to work in communities.
- Good knowledge and experience in HIV/AIDS management is a requirement
- Experience in counselling will be an added advantage
- Willingness to take on extra tasks given and occasionally work overtime.
- The ideal candidate must be a resident of Gulu or living close to the SOS Children's Village Gulu.
